

ACT 1 REVIEW OPTIONS

Learning Target: I can choose an activity to review Act 1 that fits my learning style.

INSTRUCTIONS:

For our review of Act 1, you will be choosing from 6 options. Choose the option that best fits your learning style. For example, if you really enjoy drawing, you might want to go with one of the artistic options. If you really enjoy writing, you might want to go with the writing option.

You will be completing this review in groups. Your group will present this to the class!

Note: There may be more than one group per option!

OPTION #1:

4-5 group members.

This option will consist of creating a storyboard/comic strip of the events that took place in Act 1.

Your group will complete this on a piece of poster paper. Each group member will need to contribute to the artwork.

OPTION #2:

4-5 people.

Create a snapshot of one of the scenes from Act 1.
What would the scene look like?

Each group member will need to contribute to the artwork.

OPTION #3:

4-6 people.

You may put together a skit that includes the major events of Act 1.

OPTION #4:

4-5 people.

Mannequin challenge! Your group will create a scene from Act 1 posing as mannequins. A handout with instructions will be provided for this option.

OPTION #5:

4 people.

Round robin writing!

Each person will start a scene. Make the language modern. After 3 minutes pass to other group members. Each group member will add to the story they have been given.

OPTION #6:

4 people.

Collaborate with your group to write a song or a rap that covers the events of Act 1. Each group member will need to help perform the song or rap!

EXIT TICKET:

On the piece of paper at your desk, reflect on today's lesson by responding to the following questions:

Did your group review help you better understand Act 1? Why or why not?
