- *What is a comma splice?
- *A comma splice occurs when a writer has connected two independent sentences with a comma.
- *The problem looks like this:
- *Independent sentence, independent sentence.

*AYOID COMMA SPLICES!

- *How do you fix a comma splice?
- *Use one of the FANBOYS, use a period and capitalize the second sentence. You can also use a semicolon.

*The following sentences are comma splices. Rewrite each sentence so that it is no longer a comma splice.

*Joe was running late, Sarah was on time.
