WHICH SENTENCE IS A FRAGMENT?

We walked to the store.

Walking to the library.

The dog ran to the food.

We have three days off this weekend.

HOW DO YOU FIX RUN-ON SENTENCES?

Period and capitalize, semicolon, question mark.

Period and capitalize, comma, semicolon.

Period and capitalize, comma and a FANBOY, semicolon (if the sentences are closely related in thought).

Period and capitalize, semicolon, exclamation mark.

WHICH SENTENCE USES A COMMA AFTER AN INTRODUCTORY PHRASE CORRECTLY?

Today we will be going to the museum, I can't wait to go.

Before the play starts, let's get something to eat.

Today we will be starting our essays on Julius Caesar, I am going to write about Cassius.

The sunset was so beautiful, I hope more sunrises like this occur.
