## PRINCESS BRIDE FINAL

**Instructions:** Choose one of the following options. This will count as your final for our Princess Bride/Fairy Tale unit. Make sure you do your best work! Don't race through the option you choose. Your final will be graded on the quality of your work, not just completing the option you choose. **PLEASE CIRCLE YOUR CHOICE AND ATTACH THIS SHEET WITH YOUR PROJECT!**

1. Create a detailed map of the Zoo of Death. This is from chapter 7. You will need to refer to the description given in the book. Needs to be detailed and colorful!
2. Rewrite the story line and ending of the Princess Bride. Include the same characters. Get creative! Minimum of 2 pages hand written.
3. Choose one character in the Princess Bride. Write an in depth character analysis for this character. Why do they stand out? What would they be like in real life? Get creative! Minimum of 1 1/2 pages.
4. Write your own fairy tale. Create the characters, setting, and plot. **Note:** This needs to be an original story, not a new version of a fairy tale that already exists. Minimum of 2 pages.
5. Write three poems in response to the Princess Bride or one of the fairy tales we read in class. The poems can be about the characters, where the fairy tale took place, or the themes in the book. **Each poem needs to have at least 15 lines.**
6. Write a letter to the author of the fairy tale explaining why you think they wrote the fairytale and what they were trying to show through the fairy tale. Be sure to explain what you got out of the fairy tale. Minimum of 1 1/2 pages.
7. Think of a scene from The Princess Bride that stands out to you and draw it the way that you see it. Place the characters from the scene in your picture. Then write your explanation of why you drew the scene the way that you did. This can be written on the back of your drawing. The scene must be detailed and colorful. The written explanation must be at least 5-6 sentences long.
