## Run-on Sentences

### What is a run-on sentence?

A sentence that consists of two or more independent clauses that are joined without a word to connect them or a punctuation mark to separate them.

#### **\* AVOID RUN-ON SENTENCES!!!**

#### Run-ons Look Like This:

- \* How could we fix this sentence?
- \*FANBOYS (for, and, nor, but, or, yet, so). Use a semicolon.

# How could we fix this sentence?

- Ann likes to read she goes to the library three times a week.
- Ann likes to read; she goes to the library three times a week.
- Ann likes to read, so she goes to the library three times a week.
