## SUBJECT-VERB AGRENIENT



## WHAT IS SUBJECT-VERB AGREEMENT?

- Subjects and verbs must agree with one another in number (singular or plural).
- If a subject is singular, its verb must also be singular.
- If a subject is plural, its verb must also be plural.



## EXAMPLES IN PRESENT TENSE:

- The cat chases the mouse.
- Cat-singular
- Chases-singular

- The cats chase the mouse.
- Cats-plural
- Chase-plural
