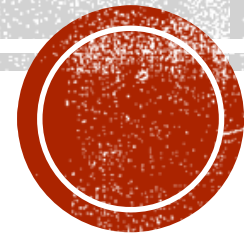


# SUBJECT-VERB AGREEMENT



# WHAT IS SUBJECT-VERB AGREEMENT?

- Subjects and verbs must agree with one another in number (singular or plural).
- If a subject is singular, its verb must also be singular.
- If a subject is plural, its verb must also be plural.



# EXAMPLES IN PRESENT TENSE:

- *The cat chases the mouse.*
- Cat-singular
- Chases-singular
  
- *The cats chase the mouse.*
- Cats-plural
- Chase-plural
